## S875 Floating Seam Tape Installation Instructions

## USE

Tarkett S875 Floating Seam Tape is a high tack, fast grabbing, acrylic, pressure sensitive tape used under seams when installing Tarkett FiberFloor™ Sheet Flooring.

Tarkett S875 Floating Seam Tape is used for "Glueless" installations of Tarkett FiberFloor over underlayment grade plywood, concrete substrates and approved existing floors.



Roll Size: 5.7" (14.4cm) x 20' (18.2m)

## **APPLICATION**

Seams on Tarkett FiberFloor™ are cut using the doublecut dry method. Do not straight edge and butt seams. After flooring has been fit and pattern match achieved (Figure 1), lay a straight edge along the center of seam overlap or along the grout line. Using the straight edge as a guide, cut through both sheets of flooring with a sharp, sturdy utility knife (Figure 2). Hold the knife straight up and down at a 90° angle to produce a vertical cut. Do not tilt knife blade. When installing over an existing floor, do not cut into the existing floor. Lift top edge of flooring and carefully remove bottom salvage piece (Figure 3).

Fold back one sheet of flooring at the seam. Position S-875 Floating Seam Tape so that it is centered under the seam cut (Figure 4). Starting at one end of the seam, carefully remove the one half of the release liner from the tape and position first half of flooring (Figure 5). Reposition second piece of flooring and make sure seam is properly aligned (Figure 6). Starting at one end of the seam, carefully remove the second half of the release liner and position second piece of flooring (Figure 7). Roll seam area with a hand roller (Figure 8).

## **SEAM SEALING**

All seams must be chemically sealed. Use the recommended seam sealer specified for the sheet flooring product that is being installed.


