

# SureShine® Cleaner and Polish

## Floor Cleaner

### Description

SureShine Floor Cleaner is a neutral floor cleaner formulated for maintaining and cleaning resilient sheet and tile flooring. May also be used with laminate flooring.

### Instructions

#### Lightly Soiled Floors

Sweep or vacuum floor to remove loose dirt. Pour one cap full of SureShine Floor Cleaner into a clean bucket. Add one gallon of water to bucket. Clean floor using a damp mop. Rinsing of floor is not required.

#### Moderately to Severely Soiled Floors

Sweep or vacuum floor to remove loose dirt. Pour 4 – 6 ounces of SureShine Floor Cleaner into a clean bucket. Add one gallon of water to bucket. Apply the cleaning solution liberally to a portion of the floor and allow 1 – 2 minutes to soak. Scrub the area using a mop or soft bristle brush. Remove excess solution. Rinse floor with clean water and allow to dry thoroughly.

#### Removal of Old Wax or Floor Polish

For removal of old wax or floor polish, follow instructions for moderately to severely soiled floors. Add ½ cup of ammonia per gallon of cleaning solution.

## High Gloss Polish

### Description

SureShine High Gloss Floor Polish is an acrylic floor finish formulated to help protect and maintain the gloss level on resilient sheet and tile flooring.

### Floor Preparation

Sweep or vacuum floor to remove loose dirt. Clean floor with SureShine Floor Cleaner. Allow floor to dry thoroughly.

### Application Instructions

Stir polish well (do not shake). Pour polish into a shallow pan or bucket. Using a clean, damp sponge mop, cheese cloth or lambs wool applicator spread polish evenly and completely. Move applicator slowly so as not to cause air bubbles.

**Note:** One liberal coat is usually adequate. However, in high traffic areas a second application will provide extra protection. Allow a minimum of 30 minutes drying time between coats.

**Coverage:** Approximately 375 sq.ft. per quart.

### Removing Floor Polish

SureShine Floor Polish is easily removed using SureShine Floor Cleaner. Follow instructions for moderately to severely soiled floors. Add ½ cup of ammonia per gallon of cleaning solution.

### Description

SureShine Low Gloss polish is an acrylic floor finish formulated to help protect and maintain the gloss level on resilient sheet and tile flooring.

### Floor Preparation

Sweep or vacuum floor to remove loose dirt. Clean floor with SureShine Floor Cleaner. Allow floor to dry thoroughly.

### Application Instructions

Stir polish well (do not shake). Pour polish into a shallow pan or bucket. Using a clean, damp sponge mop, cheese cloth or lambs wool applicator spread polish evenly and completely. Move applicator slowly so as not to cause air bubbles.
